This application will be used by the Scholarship Awards Committee to assist in the selection of endowment scholarship recipients. Only Undergraduate Students are eligible to apply. Qualifying students must meet minimum requirements listed below to be eligible for scholarships awards. Ten recipients will receive a minimum of \$2,000 each; the recipients will be announced during the Awards Banquet in May 2011.

Please initial each criterion to verify that you understand the qualification requirements. Failure to do so will disqualify your application.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Initial

DEADLINE April 4, 2011. Please submit a complete Undergraduate Scholarship Application, an **official** copy of SAT or ACT scores, an **official** school transcript and a photograph. Please affix your name and home address to the back of a photograph. Current college students need only to submit transcript of grades. In order to ensure a fair process, **NO EXTENSIONS** will be granted. The deadline date is the U.S. Postal date stamp indicated above. **Faxed submissions will not be accepted.**

ENROLLMENT

- ___ Must have written evidence of acceptance to an accredited college/university for 2011 fall school year.
- ___ Current college students must have proof of "C" average; **GPA will be a final determining selection factor along with other criteria.**
- ___ Please attach a copy of your institution's rating system to clarify any numbered grade such as 4.0 as an A or 2.5 as a C.

RECOMMENDATIONS

___ Must have at least three letters of recommendation from people other than relatives, dated and addressed to the CBTU Scholarship Committee. **(Repeat applicants do not send same letters year after year.)**

CBTU SPONSOR

___ Provide the name, relationship, signature and contact number of the CBTU member who is the sponsor of scholarship applicant to the Scholarship Awards Committee. **Sponsor must be a current dues paid member recorded in the National CBTU Office by April 26 of current year.**

ESSAY

___ Must submit a typewritten essay of no less than 300 words, subjects as follows, **freshman year students essay subject: Why Should Young People get Involved in Politics? For applicants entering their sophomore year the essay is to be entitled: Leadership and Services, What does it Mean. In addition include in your essay an example of your Leadership and Service. Titled essays for students in their junior year, "Valuing our Vote;" The student who has reached the senior year is asked to present an essay entitled: A College Education, Provides Me Choices.** Essays will be judged on content, grammar, sentence structure and punctuation. **(Please note, "I", "to", "a" will not be considered words for the purpose of the word count of 300)**
